Each year, MYP encourages members to participate in Leadership Marshfield, a program from the Marshfield Area Chamber of Commerce & Industry which is designed to identify current and potential leaders in the community and provide training that will enhance their ability to function as more effective leaders.

MACCI's first Leadership Class graduated in May 1993. Now, 23 years later, the 2016 class includes several MYP members: Renee Binder, John Kaprelian, Charlie Wendlandt, and Brooke Wolff. During the program, members participate in a series of eight informative one day sessions and develop group projects designed to meet each individual's interests and community needs.

Brooke Wolff was the recipient of the 2015 MYP Leadership Marshfield Scholarship, which is awarded to eligible members to cover the program attendance costs. Her team's community project will make a difference in the lives of students at Washington Elementary this fall with the creation of Marshfield School District's first Outdoor Classroom.
